Archibald William Lingo, age 78 of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 2, 2021, at his residence. He was born on April 1, 1943, in Lewes, DE, son of the late William H. Lingo and Eleanor W. (Lynch) Lingo.

Archie was a graduate of the old Rehoboth High School, and after college he began his career of 47 years as a Pilot for the Bay and River Delaware. Archie was also the former owner and operator of Lingo's Market in Rehoboth Beach, where he developed many loyal customers and friendships over the years.

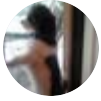
