Robert Lofland, age 87 of Lewes, DE, passed away at home after a long illness on Thursday, November 4, 2021. He was born on April 1, 1934, in Wilmington, DE, son of the late John C. and Maude E. (Knowles) Lofland.

Mr. Lofland graduated high school in 1952. He continued his studies at Goldey -Beacom College in Wilmington, DE. On June 8, 1963, Mr. Lofland married the love of his life, Fay Adkins. He was a proud veteran, having honorably served in the US Army. After his honorable discharge, Mr. Lofland enjoyed a lifelong career with Delmarva Power, retiring after 32 dedicated years. He also worked for 5 years as a real estate agent in the Lewes area.
