**D**avid A. Mason, age 61, passed away in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware on Wednesday November 24, 2021, of metastatic melanoma. He was born in Rahway, NJ on December 23, 1959, son of the late Richard and Mary Frances (Cifre) Mason.

Dave's family moved to Lancaster, PA when he was a child. He graduated from Lancaster Country Day School. Dave went on to study at Franklin and Marshall College, graduating in 1982 with a degree in Government.

Knowing he always wanted to be his own boss, he started his business while still in college. Initially he painted houses and later was a general contractor in Lancaster.
