Carol S. Ewing, age 90 of Rehoboth Beach, DE and formerly of Wilmington, DE, closed her circle of life on February 28, 2022. She was born on August 31, 1931, in Ashland, PA, daughter of the late William F. and Mabel (Balliet) Smith.

Carol was a graduate of Henry C. Conrad High School in Wilmington, DE, Class of 1949. She always felt every class reunion to be a special time with her many friends. Carol was also a graduate of Goldey-Beacom College and worked for Hercules, Inc. as an executive secretary, retiring after 28 dedicated years. In 1991, she and her husband, Bob, built a home in Rehoboth Beach, and Sussex County became home to them. 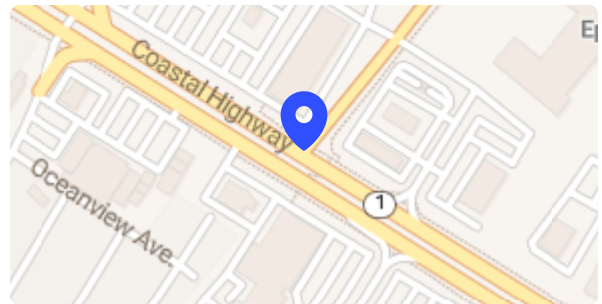

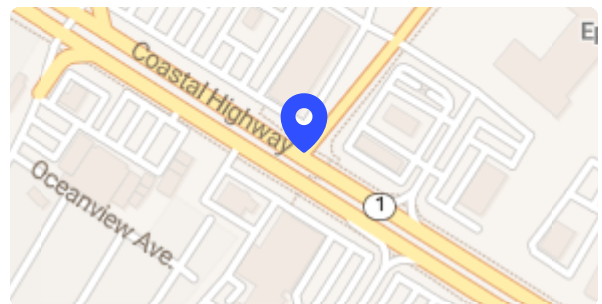
