Margaret “Peggy” Elizabeth Hudson, age 91 of Lewes, DE, passed away on Tuesday, March 29, 2022, at Delaware Hospice Center, in Milford, DE. She was born on June 26, 1930, in Lewes, daughter of the late William and Eva Thompson.

Peggy was born and raised in town on Market Street. She worked at Beebe Healthcare in the Registrar’s Office for nearly 30 years. She was known to everyone in town, and many fondly remember Peggy sitting on her front porch, enjoying her hometown and all the passersby. She was a founding member of the Doo-Da Parade, as well. 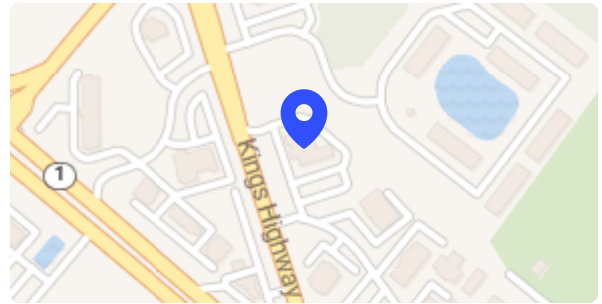

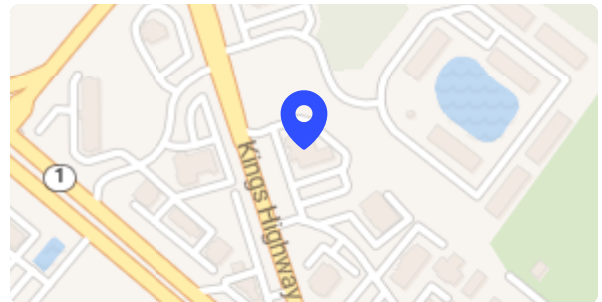
