# George Frederick Sullivan

**G**eorge Frederick Sullivan, age 90 of Millsboro, DE, passed away on Friday, April 15, 2022, at his home. He was born on October 15, 1931, in Yonkers, NY, son of the late John J. and Mabel (McCauley) Sullivan.

Mr. Sullivan served honorably in the U. S. Air Force for four years during the Korean Conflict. He was a graduate of Penn State, Class of 1958, earning a Bachelor's Degree in business administration. Mr. Sullivan held management positions in both the dairy and plastics industries. He loved staying active, especially sailing, skiing, and playing tennis and golf.
