**P**aul G. Bingham, age 90 of Milton, DE and formerly of Annapolis, MD, passed away on Saturday, June 4, 2022, at his home. He was born on April 9, 1932, in Nashua, NH, son of the late Paul G. Sr. and Mary (Peabody) Bingham.

Mr. Bingham was a proud veteran, having honorably served in the United States Coast Guard during the Korean War. His love of the sea would lead him to a lifelong career working in and around the waterways of the Eastern Shore. He was a jack of all trades: a diesel engine mechanic, the captain of a private yacht, and he enjoyed a twenty-five-year career with the Maryland Department of Natural Resources working in Code Enforcement.
