Andrew Harvey Bulles, age 77 of Ocean View, DE, passed away on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes, DE. He was born on November 14, 1944, in Washington, DC, son of the late Fay and Betty Bulles.

Mr. Bulles enjoyed a lifelong career in entertainment. He was an on-air radio personality at Key 103.1 in Frederick, MD and a talent-booking agent for Barry Rick Associates in Gaithersburg, MD; and performed as a deejay for Davis Deejays, Bialek's Music, and Maximum Talent. Mr. Bulles also spent many years as a deejay at the Ocean City American Legion, Ocean City Elks Club, and the Delmarva Hand Dance Club in both Ocean City, MD and Selbyville, DE. His hobbies and interests spanned well beyond the music he loved, however. Mr. Bulles was an avid car enthusiast and a former member of the Delmarva Corvette Club in Ocean City. Above all, he cherished time spent with those he held most dear. Mr. Bulles was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and friend. Loved by many, he will be deeply missed by all who had the good fortune to know him.

Mr. Bulles is survived by his beloved wife of 56 years, Dolores of Ocean View, DE; his children and spouses: Andrew R. 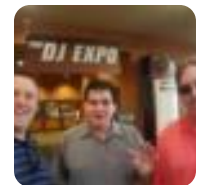

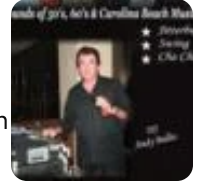
