Robert T. Aulgur, Jr., age 71 of Milton, DE, passed away gently in the company of his family at Christiana Hospital on Monday, August 29, 2022. He was born on May 10, 1951, in St. Louis, MO, son of the late Robert T, Sr. & Melvena Aulgur.

Bob was a graduate of Yorktown High School, in Arlington, VA, Class of 1969. He continued his education at the Defense Language Institute, Monterey, CA 1971, Ball State University-Bachelor of Arts Cum Laude 1973, and Syracuse University-Juris Doctorate 1976. He was admitted to the Delaware Bar In 1977 and to the U.S Court of Military Appeals in 1982.

Bob was a proud veteran, having served as Sergeant in the US Army. His patriotism continued after his honorable discharge from the Army with his enlistment in the US Navy Reserve, from which he retired as Commander.

Bob quickly became a partner at the Wilmington law firm of Wilson, Whittington & Aulgur after his admittance to the Delaware Bar, and from 1984 until his retirement in 2015, he was the managing partner at Whittington & Aulgur. He served as Chief Attorney for the Delaware House of Representatives from 1982-1983 and as a councilman for the Smyrna Town Council.

In his younger years, Bob was a competitive bicyclist, an avid outdoorsman, and had a strong love for boating throughout his life. He had an intellectual curiosity that kept him interested in learning, particularly studying history. He was a long-time member of the American Legion Post 28.

Bob is survived by his wife, Melissa Clark Aulgur; his children: Terry Aulgur (Lisa), William Todd Aulgur (Angela), and Anna Klement (Jeff); his grandchildren: Jack, William, Benjamin, Evelina, Conner, and Ronin; his sister, Jeanne Whitney (Keith); his niece, Eva; and his great-niece, Mia.

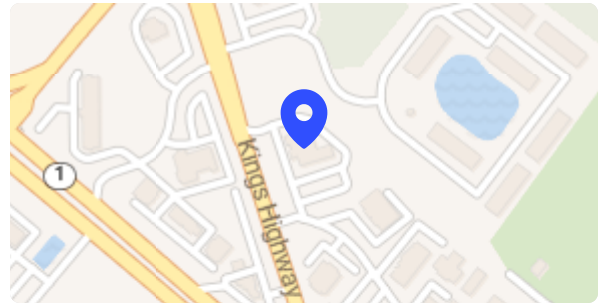

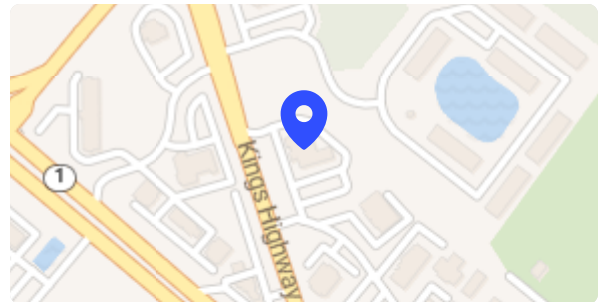
