John L. Marowski, age 80 of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his family on Saturday, September 3, 2022, after a lengthy battle with cancer. He was born on April 10, 1942, in Wilmington, DE, the son of the late Joseph and Loretta (Klingler) Marowski.

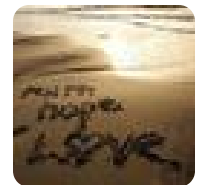
