**J**ane Ann Noughra, age 54 of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully on Monday, September 5, 2022, surrounded by her family at her home, following a year-long battle with cancer. She was born on January 8, 1968, in Clearfield, PA, daughter of Duane and Sibbie (Baer) Rowles.

Jane was a graduate of Clearfield High School, Class of 1986 and continued her education at the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy, graduating in 1991. She married J.
