Harry Michael "Mike" Hunt, age 79 of Millsboro, DE, passed away on Friday, November 19, 2022, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes, DE. He was born on August 29, 1943, in Morgantown, WV, son of the late Harry M. and Kathryn (Brewer) L. Hunt.

Mr. Hunt graduated from high school in 1961, and after graduation, he proudly served in the US Army as a military police officer. Following his honorable discharge, Mr. Hunt married the love of his life, Kathleen, on September 27, 1969, and together they raised their beautiful family. He worked as a supervisor and a claims adjuster for NJ MFG Insurance, retiring in 2000 after many dedicated years.

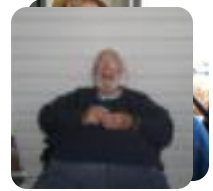
