Our family sadly announces the passing of a devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend William (Bill) Donald Woodhall of Lewes, Delaware, who entered into eternal rest in South Carolina on Monday, December 12, 2022, at the age of 89. Pastor Woodhall was born on February 5, 1933, in Punxsutawney, Pennsylvania, son of the late Walter and Crissie Vieta Woodhall. He was also preceded in death by his wife Edna Woodhall and a sister Ethel Merryman.

He was a devoted pastor of First Baptist Church in Lewes, Delaware for 35 plus years and at Central Baptist Church in Memphis, Tennessee for 4 years.
