Buzz Gildea, age 80 of Lewes, DE, formerly of Wilmington, passed away after a courageous battle with cancer, on Tuesday, February 7, 2023, at Beebe Healthcare. He was born on April 19, 1942, in Wilmington, DE, son of the late Francis and Catherine Gildea.

Buzz proudly retired from the Air National Guard and a career firefighter, retiring after 42 years as Battalion Chief with the City of Wilmington Fire Department. His hard work and dedication earned him the respect of not only his peers, but those who ranked above and below him throughout his tenure.

Buzz was a man of many interests. His hobbies ranged from home repair to ballroom dancing, and he enjoyed working outdoors and had a fascination with trains. 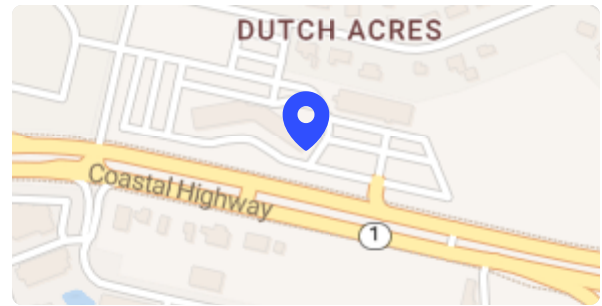

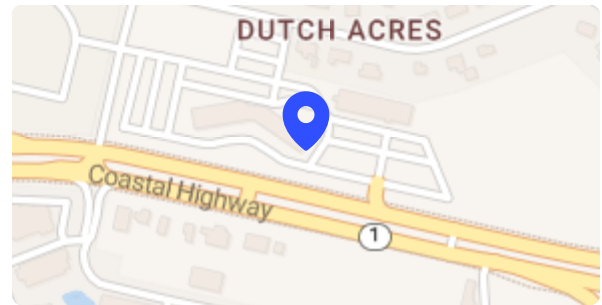

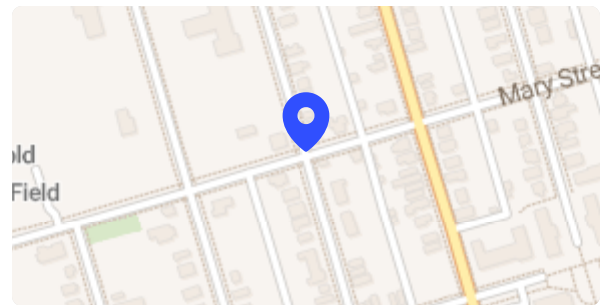
