Floyd K. "Gus" Nelson, age 95, of Milton, DE passed away peacefully on January 29, 2023. Born in Bradford, PA he was the son of the late Floyd and Isabelle (Giles) Nelson of Bradford, PA.

Floyd worked for Dresser and Plexowood Manufacturing in Bradford, PA prior to retirement and moving to Delaware. He was a proud veteran, stationed at Camp Perry during WWII while serving his country in the United States Navy. He was a 32nd Degree Free and Accepted Mason.

Floyd was an avid outdoorsman who loved to hunt deer from his hunting lodge. He was a master craftsman who built all his homes with his wife, Anna, by his side. Earlier in their marriage, Floyd and Anna enjoyed travel and together they explored and discovered much of the wonders of the United States together. He was a friend to many, ready to lend a helping hand. Floyd believed in helping those who may not be able to help themselves and he dedicated many hours to charity work - quietly and without seeking recognition. His devotion to his family, however, took precedence above all and the time spent with those he held dear was what he cherished most.
