Angelo Charles Pantuliano Sr., age 77 of Lewes, DE passed away peacefully on Sunday, June 11, 2023. He was born on October 10, 1945, in Wilmington, DE, son of the late Anthony J. and Mary (Hollingsworth) Pantuliano.

Mr. Pantuliano was a proud veteran, having honorably served in the US Army National Guard. He was extremely proud to have worked on the Apollo 13 mission, the seventh crewed mission in the Apollo space program, and the third meant to land on the moon.
