Edward Ploskon, age 99 of Millsboro, DE passed away on Tuesday, August 1, 2023, at Delaware Hospice, in Milford, DE. He was born on March 15, 1924, in New Castle, DE, son of the late John and Agnes Ploskon.

Mr. Ploskon was born and raised in "South Side" Wilmington, DE. He was a proud US Army veteran of World War II, having honorably served for 3 years overseas in the European Theater. 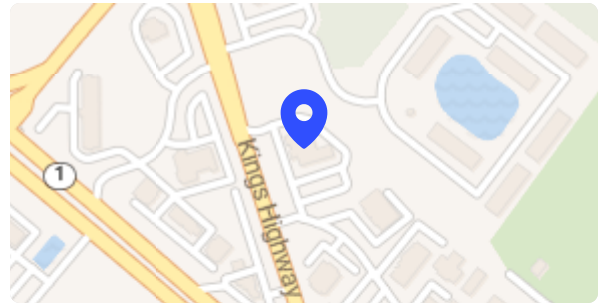

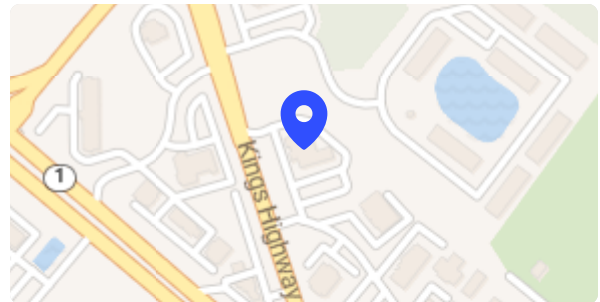

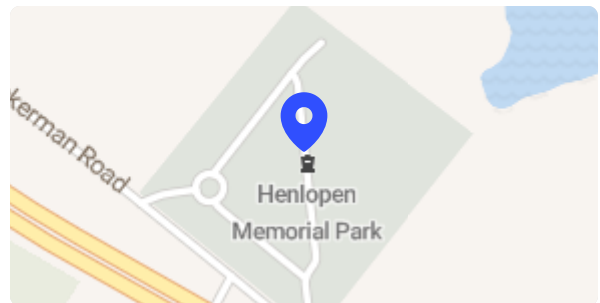
