Barbara Chudzik, age 75 of Wilmington and Lewes, DE, passed away on Monday, October 2, 2023. She was born on December 12, 1947, in Wilmington, daughter of the late Howard “Buzz” and Anne “Nancy” Whitten.

Barbara graduated from St. Elizabeth High School, then went on to work for DuPont and the Superior Court of Delaware. 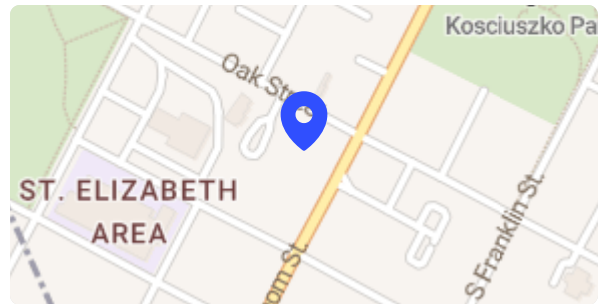

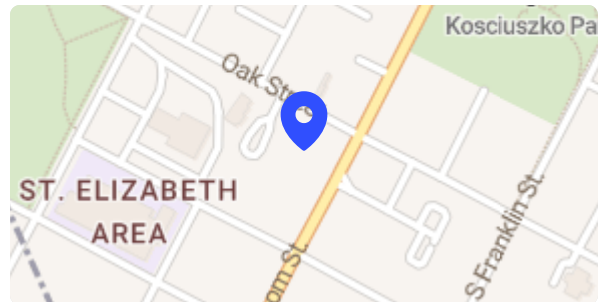
