Richard Jay Warren, age 93 of Lewes, DE passed away on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, at Delaware Hospice, in Milford, DE. He was born on July 27, 1930, in Brooklyn, NY, son of the late William Seligman and Julia Levine.

Mr. Warren answered the call to serve his country and proudly served in the US Army during the Korean War.
