Beverly Stadler passed away peacefully on August 19, 2024, at Atlantic Shores in Millsboro, DE. She was a loving mother and grandmother. She was born on February 27, 1944, to Carl and Gertrude Seeger. Mrs. Stadler was raised in New Jersey with her parents and brother, Norman.

Mrs. Stadler wed Francis (Frank) Stadler and moved to Bloomingdale NJ to start their family. She worked as a nurse for 30 years at Chilton Memorial Hospital. Beverly was very active in her church at Jacksonville Chapel NJ with bible study, volunteering as a greeter, Sunday school, Vacation Bible School, and has gone on a few mission trips too.

After the death of her husband, Frank, the Stadler family moved to Delaware, where she then raised their two children: Jason and Andrea. In Delaware, Beverly found a new church community at Eagle's Nest Fellowship Church. She was very active there as well with small groups, being a greeter and attending any events that the church would plan.
