Ronald "Ron" C. Ailey Sr., age 86, of Trenton, NJ, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Thursday, November 21, 2024.

Born on October 13, 1938, in Trenton, NJ, Ron was the son of the late Carl and Doris Ailey.

He was a lifelong area resident and also a 20 year resident of Fort Myers, Florida, where he was a member at the Heritage Palms Country Club.
