He is survived by his cousins in Calci, Italy—Roberto, Giulia, and numerous others—as well as many dear friends. Geno was a proud graduate of Florida State University, where he majored in Geography, History, and Italian. He was an active member of his fraternity, Phi Gamma Delta.

Geno’s passions were many. He loved everything Italian, traveling, history, geography, Harleys, cooking, photography, stamp collecting, camping, and, of course, the music of Jimmy Buffett. He was a very loyal friend, deeply patriotic, and had a profound love for his country.
