Michael Dale Hastings, age 62, of Ellendale, Delaware, passed away peacefully on Friday, May 2, 2025, at Jefferson University Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Mr. Hastings was born on June 3, 1962, son of the late Richard Hastings and Frances Jane (Bowden) Jefferson. He was a graduate of Woodbridge High School, Class of 1980, and spent many years working as a technician for Timmons Amusements, where he specialized in servicing vending machines.

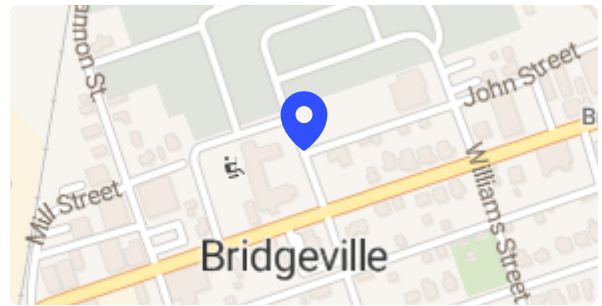

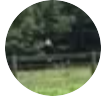
