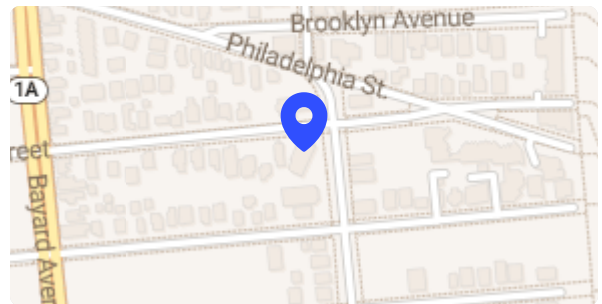

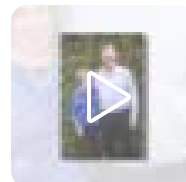
Ted Lacki posted:
