William F. “Fred” Horn, 71, of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Saturday, February 7, 2026. He was born on August 5, 1954, in Lancaster, PA. Son of the late William F. Horn and Hazel I. (Shuman) Horn Ciccone. Fred was the beloved husband of Patricia A. Horn; they celebrated their 51st wedding anniversary on January 11th.

Fred was a successful architect. Becoming a licensed architect in the Commonwealth of Virginia in 1992 while working for the HSMM Architectural firm in Virginia Beach, VA. In 1994, he moved to Delaware where he worked for BM2OR in Salisbury, MD. During that time, he became a registered architect in the states of Maryland and Delaware. In 1997, he became an entrepreneur and started his own firm, W. F. Horn Architect, Inc., which was very successful for 28 years.

Fred was a 32nd degree York Rite Mason. An active member of the Jefferson Lodge, No. 15 AF & AM in Lewes, DE. Fred was also a past commander of the Knights Templar at Saint Andrews Commandry, No. 2 in Dover, DE.

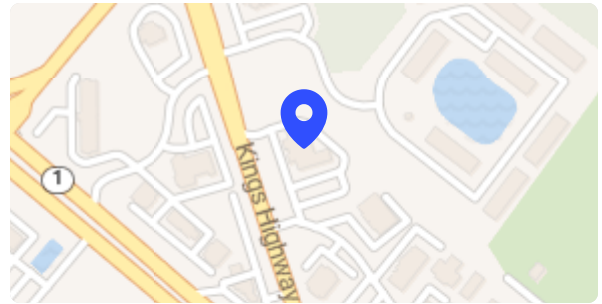

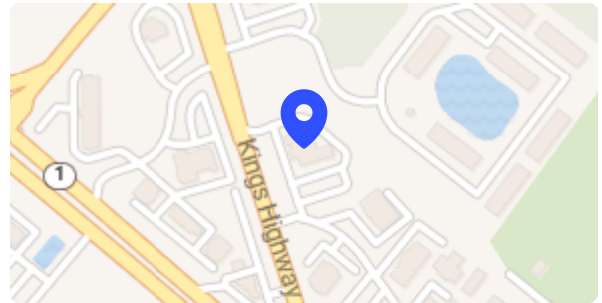
