**C**arol Joan Truss (68), beloved wife, sister and aunt, passed from this life on February 14, 2026 at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia.

Carol was born on August 20, 1957 in Staten Island, New York to Rose and Arthur Truss. She was the youngest of 3 children. She was confirmed in the Calvary Presbyterian Church.

Carol graduated from Susan E Wagner High School in Staten Island, from Monmouth College in 1979, “number one” in her class, from Fairleigh Dickinson University in 1982 with a Masters Degree in Psychology and from Rutgers University Law School in 1985 with a Juris Doctor degree.

On June 17, 1998 Carol married her love, and life partner, Alan Pettit. They shared the passions of skiing, golfing, boating and wine making. Carol was the past president of the Central Jersey Ski Club with whom Alan and Carol skied not only in North America but also France, Italy, and Switzerland. Carol played the piano and was fluent in Spanish having studied in Spain.

Carol was generous with her time with her nieces and nephew on special outings to hockey games and skiing trips to New England. She lovingly cared for her mother in the final years of her life.

Carol was the “HI” that rivals modern day “AI.” Carl Gross, her lifelong professional partner, stated unequivocally that her human intelligence (HI ) was above all others and that he owes his success to her intellect and dedication.
