Bonnie was born in Washington, DC on March 20, 1933 and received her Everlasting Reward on February 18, 2020. Bonnie moved to Rehoboth Beach in 2010 and spent the past 4 ½ years in the loving hearts and hands of the staff at Country Rest Home in Greenwood, DE.

Bonnie was a born leader, having been a long-time Girl Scout Leader, a member of the Golden Techites (1951) for over 70 years, Sigma Epsilon Sorority, and Past Sovereign Grand Master of Schuyler Colfax #10 Rebekah Lodge, Independent Order of Odd Fellows (IOOF).
