Rain drops wouldn't deter her from walking, and she frequently could be sighted walking the loop through Gull Point.

Later in life, while losing her sight, she became involved with BlindSight Delaware and resumed her passion for reading through audio books. As life slowed down, Carolyn took pleasure in the little things, a pop up card with flowers inside, a bowl of prayer wishes, a quart of home made soup from a neighbor or a call about almost nothing. Never old, always young at heart, she will be dearly missed by family, friends and neighbors.
