George "Danny" Daniels Jr., 77 years old, passed away in the presence of loving family at The Moorings in Lewes, Delaware on Saturday, March 16, 2019. He was born January 27, 1942 to the late George H., Sr. and Mary Daniels of Wilmington, Delaware.

Danny was a graduate of Salesianum High School and went on to become a 50+ year union pipefitter through Local 74 of Wilmington, Delaware.
