George S. Kuhlman, age 81 of Seaford, DE, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at his home. He was born on September 29, 1939 in Seaford, DE, son of the late Henry and Helen Kuhlman.

Mr. Kuhlman was an electrician by trade, contributing many dedicated years to the DuPont Company. He was a proud member of the Army National Guard, serving for 7 years. His National Guard unit was called in to help evacuate those trapped during the infamous 1962 Nor'easter. Above all, he cherished time spent with those he held most dear, especially supporting his grandchildren at their sporting events and watching them grow. In addition to his parents, Mr. Kuhlman was preceded in death by his brothers: Charles Kuhlman and Edward Kuhlman; and his sisters: Jean Lovell and Ruth Kuhlman. He is survived by his beloved wife of 52 years, Marie (Rogers) Kuhlman of Seaford, DE; his son Brett Kuhlman and his wife Amy of Milton, DE; his grandchildren: Katie Kuhlman and Cody Kuhlman, both of Milton, DE; and his many nieces and nephews.
