John Anthony Bucci "Jack", 83 of Lewes, DE passed away Monday, April 27, 2020. He was born on February 28, 1937 in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late Anthony and Frances (Trask) Bucci.

Jack was a proud veteran, having honorably served in the US Army. He built a career in law enforcement, dedicating many years to the City of Philadelphia as a police officer.
